Re: Your November 26, 2023 Request for BWXT Police Department Policy Manual

Dear Mr. Stevenson:

BWXT Nuclear Operations Group, Inc. ("BWXT NOG" or the "Company") is in receipt of your email message dated November 26, 2023, in which you request the BWXT Police Department Policy Manual in accordance with the Virginia Freedom of Information Act ("VFOIA"), Virginia Code § 2.2-3700 et seq.

BWXT NOG has no responsive records. Although the Company maintains a Special Purpose Police Department, it does not independently maintain a police department policy manual. Instead, BWXT NOG's security officers receive law enforcement training from the Central Virginia Criminal Justice Academy and rely on Virginia's law enforcement policies when executing the limited police powers that have been granted by the Commonwealth of Virginia.

The Company does maintain policies related to the physical security of its personnel, facilities, and assets. Please note that a future request for such records may be withheld under Virginia Code § 2.2-3704(B). Specifically, information is excluded from disclosure pursuant to Virginia Code § 2.2-3705.2(14)(b) to the extent the requested information constitutes the specific security plans and measures of an entity, facility, building not lawfully available to the public pursuant to applicable orders and regulations from the Department of Energy ("DOE") and the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") the disclosure of which would jeopardize the safety or security of any person, building, or structure or persons using such facility, building, or structure.
